This assignment will help you to explore new genres and find new books to read! For this assignment, you must get four in a row to get BINGO by reading a book from the genre listed in the BINGO spaces. Your BINGO can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal.

Requirements:

- No double dipping! One book cannot count for more than one space.
- To count for your BINGO, it must be a book that you've never read before.
- Add the title of the book you read and the response activity that you completed for that book to the space you're counting for your BINGO.
- For each book you read, complete an activity from the Response Activity Menu included in this packet.

BONUS: Read a book from the genre in EVERY SPACE to get a BLACKOUT and receive a free book from Mrs. Sugrue!

These response activities can be completed on your blog or by hand on paper. Keep all of your response activities until the day that the assignment is due in class.

Response Activity	Instructions
<i>Social Media Post</i>	Create a social media profile for the main character and include comments from minor characters as well. Try to integrate key quotes from the book. Get the social media profile template from Mrs. Sugrue
<i>Letter to a Character</i>	Write a letter to a character of your choice from your book. What would you say to this character now that you've finished the book? Do you have questions for them? Should they have done something differently?
<i>Letter to the Author</i>	Write a letter to the author, even if the author is no longer living. What do you want to say to the author? What do you want to ask the author?
<i>Make a Connection</i>	Answer the following questions in at least 2 paragraphs (10 sentences). How does the book connect to another text such as a song, film, novel, poem, painting, sculpture, etc.? What does it remind you of? How does the book connect to a current, historical, or personal event?
<i>#Hashtag It</i>	Create a list of 10-15 clever, original #hashtags for the book that you read. These hashtags can be about characters, plot, your reaction to the book, etc.
<i>Word Cloud</i>	Make a list of key words from the book and create a word cloud online or on paper. Ask Mrs. Sugrue for examples if you have questions.
<i>Six Word Memoirs</i>	Choose three characters from the book and write a six word memoir for each character. A memoir is like an autobiography or a personal account of an experience.
<i>Anthem</i>	If the protagonist and the antagonist from your book could select any song as his/her anthem (fight song, motto), what would it be and why? Choose a song for the protagonist and the antagonist in your book, and explain why you chose those songs.
<i>Create a New Cover</i>	Create new cover art for your book and then answer these questions in at least 2 complete sentences. Why did you decide to make the changes you made? What about the book inspired this cover?
<i>Mind Map</i>	Sketch the interior mind of the protagonist and/or antagonist's thoughts. What does it look like inside this character's mind?
